Trail Stop Recap

In the beginning, God created a perfect home where His people could live with Him. When Adam and Eve sinned, they could no longer live in that perfect home with God. From that moment, all people needed a Savior. Throughout the Old Testament, God reminded His people that He would one day send Jesus to be our Savior. After God gave Moses the Ten Commandments, He told him to build a very special tent called the tabernacle. Ever since leaving Egypt, God had been leading His people by a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night. Now, God's presence would rest in a special room inside the tabernacle.

God gave Moses exact instructions for how to build the tabernacle. The tabernacle would be a place for the people to worship God and every part of it pointed to Jesus. Once a year, the high priest would enter the most holy place in the tabernacle to make a sacrifice for the sins of the people. Only the high priest could go into God's presence, but Jesus has made a way for all to be in His presence. And one day, He will return and bring all who trust in Him into a perfect, forever home with Him.
