One day, Jesus and His disciples went to the town of Bethsaida, and a large crowd followed Him. Jesus welcomed the crowd and began to teach them. As the day went on, the disciples suggested that Jesus send the people home so they could find food to eat. Instead, Jesus told the disciples to feed the crowd themselves.

The disciples were confused because the only food they had was five loaves of bread and two fish—certainly not enough to feed such a large crowd. But Jesus is able to do the impossible. He took the food they had, gave thanks, and told the disciples to distribute it. Everyone in the crowd had enough to eat, and there were even twelve baskets of food left over.

Jesus is powerful and can do what seems impossible. Just as He provided for the crowd, He provides for us too. Even when things feel impossible, we can trust Jesus to take care of our needs. Jesus is powerful! He provided food for the crowd and He provides eternal life for all who put their trust in Him.

Continuing on the Trail at Home

This week, talk with your child about how Jesus cared for the big crowd by providing food when it seemed impossible. Look for everyday moments to remind them that Jesus provides for our needs too. For example, food, family, and everything we have comes from Him. Pray together before meals and thank Jesus for being our Provider. You can also ask your child to name something they are thankful Jesus has given them and remind them that they can trust Jesus to take care of them every day.
