Bible Passage Exodus 1-2:10

Big Truth

God is faithful and keeps His promises.

Application I can trust God because He always does what He says.

Journey Through God's Word

Long before Moses was born, God had promised a man named Abraham that He would grow his family into a great nation. This nation would be different from other nations. They would be set apart and they would be His people. God would give them a land all their own, but first they would be slaves in a land that wasn't theirs. God kept His promise and Abraham's family grew into a great nation called the Israelites. They were living in Egypt.

Pharaoh was the king of Egypt and when he saw how many Israelites there were, he became afraid. He worried they would become stronger than the Egyptians and fight against the Egyptians, so Pharaoh made them slaves who had to work very hard. Still, the Israelites grew in number and eventually, Pharaoh ordered for every Hebrew baby boy to be killed. When Moses was born, his mom kept him. When she could no longer hide him, she placed him in a basket and set him in the river. Pharaoh's daughter found him and brought him to Pharaoh's palace where he would grow up. God was faithful to keep His promise to Abraham and He is still faithful today. God saved Moses and He was making a way to save His people from the Egyptians.

Journey Together at Home

Ask your child why baby Moses needed to be hidden and who protected him. Talk about how God was keeping His promises even before Moses was grown. Share a time when your family saw God provide or protect in a special way. This week, practice saying Psalm 145:13b together and remind your child that God always does what He says.
