Journey Through God's Word

The Israelites had left Egypt, made it through the Red Sea, and now they were continuing their journey to the land God had promised them. It had been a little over a month since leaving Egypt and the Israelites were hungry. They began to grumble and complain and once again, they said they should have stayed in Egypt. The Lord had been faithful in Egypt and He would continue to be faithful throughout their journey. Moses told the people God would provide food each day for them. Each morning they should gather enough food for that day, but no more. He was teaching them to trust God's provision. Each morning, bread would fall from the sky, but when the people went out to gather food for their families, some of them gathered extra to save for the next day. When they woke up the next morning, the food they had saved was rotten and crawling with bugs!! Still, the Lord provided new food that morning. On the sixth day, the Lord told the people to gather enough food for two days, because the seventh day was the Sabbath and the people should rest. The people did as the Lord told them. On the morning of the seventh day, the food they had saved was still good! Again, the Lord showed His faithfulness and power to provide for His people. We can continue to trust His faithfulness to make a way for us today.
