Journey Through God's Word

It had been three months since leaving Egypt. God had given the Israelites the Ten Commandments along with other laws. Moses had been on the mountain with God for forty days. The Israelites had promised to obey all that God told them to do, but like us, the Israelites were not perfect.

God had shown His faithfulness to the Israelites in Egypt and throughout their journey as He led them to the Promised Land. But now, the Israelites were growing impatient. Moses had been up on the mountain with God for quite a while. They didn't know if he would ever come back down. God had gone before them throughout their journey, but the Israelites decided to make their own god who would lead them. God saw what was happening. He told Moses the people had already turned away from Him. The people had sinned and God would punish them for their sin. Moses interceded for the people and God didn't give them the punishment they deserved. The people needed someone like Moses to rescue them, but they needed someone much bigger than Moses. They needed a Savior. One day, God would send Jesus to make a way to deliver all who put their trust in Him.

Journey Together at Home

Ask your child what the Israelites did while Moses was on the mountain. Talk about how waiting can be hard, but God is always worthy of our trust. Help your child think of one way they can trust God instead of complaining or becoming impatient this week. Practice Proverbs 3:5-6 together.
