Bible Passage Joshua 23

Main Point

God sets leaders in place.

Application

I can trust and obey God.

Today's Discovery

God had raised up Joshua to lead the Israelites into the Promised Land, but Joshua knew he would not be their leader forever. Before he died, Joshua gathered Israel's leaders and reminded them how the Lord had brought them out of Egypt, cared for them in the wilderness, given them the land He had promised, and given them victory over their enemies.

Joshua encouraged the people to love the Lord, obey His commands, and remember that God had always been faithful to keep His promises. He reminded them that if they continued to follow the Lord, He would continue to be with them and fight for them.

Joshua would not always be Israel's leader, but God would continue to raise up leaders for His people. Even the best earthly leaders could never lead perfectly. Just like us, the Israelites didn't follow God perfectly and needed a Savior. One day, God would send Jesus, the perfect King, who would lead His people forever and make a way for everyone who trusts in Him to live in their forever home with Him.
