Jesus Enters Jerusalem as King

Lesson Summary

In Matthew 21:1-11, Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey during the Passover celebration. This fulfilled the prophecy from Zechariah 9:9 about the Messiah riding in peacefully on the back of a donkey, which showed Jesus was king. The people recognized Jesus from the many miracles He had performed. They laid down palm branches before Jesus while crying out "Hosanna," which means "save us, we pray." As He was riding on the colt, people began to proclaim that Jesus is King. This was a reference to Psalm 118, which spoke about the coming Messiah. Jesus is the Messiah King. There were three groups of people in the crowd: the Jews who did not believe in Jesus, the crowd from Galilee, and those who saw Jesus raise Lazarus from the dead. The Jews saw this happening but still didn't believe Jesus was the Messiah God. We can know Jesus absolutely is the Messiah, who fulfilled the prophecy given in Zechariah. Praise God for keeping His promises!
