6.	Jesus said He spoke the things in this passage in order that we may have joy. What things lead to joy? How are the things that lead us to joy in direct opposition from what the world teaches?
7.	Why do you think Jesus ties abiding with Him together with loving others? Can we be "good with Jesus" while NOT loving others? Please explain your answer.
