Lesson Summary:

In Joshua 6:1-27, the battle of Jericho brought fulfillment to the promise God made to Abraham regarding the Promised Land. This battle was not just a military battle but a religious one. God instructed Joshua and the Israelites on how the battle would be won. The Ark of the Covenant was carried in front of the people as a sign that God was with them in battle. They were told to march around Jericho for six days, while the priests would blow the trumpets. Then, on the seventh day, after the priests blew the trumpets, Joshua told the Israelites to shout, for God had given them the city of Jericho. In Hebrews 11:30, we see the walls fell by the power of God and the people's faith in God. We too can put our faith in God, no matter what battles we may face, knowing God is with us as believers in Him.
