Matthew 6:25-34

Lesson Summary- Expedition Overview

In Matthew 6:25-34, we continue reading about the Sermon on the Mount given by Jesus, starting in chapter 5. At the beginning of chapter 6, Jesus warned us about the importance of living for God and not for the things of this world. If our focus is on gaining material things in this life, we are missing it completely. We are focusing on the here and now instead of thinking of God with an eternal focus. Starting in verse 25, Jesus went on to say that if we are focused on gaining the things of this world, the result will be living with worry. The birds and the flowers aren't worried about what is happening because God is their Creator who cares for them. We are so much more important to God than the birds and flowers. We can focus on God and seek to bring Him glory. God will provide for us as we live our lives focused on Him and not things of this earth. We can trust that God loves us and will take care of us.
