Lesson Summary:

In Genesis 11, we read about the Tower of Babel. The word *Babel* means confusion. Even after the flood and a fresh start for humanity, the world quickly filled again with sinful people. At the end of Genesis 10, we learn that everyone on earth spoke the same language. The people settled in a place called Shinar (Babylon). In the Bible, Babylon often represents a place filled with sin and rebellion against God. God had commanded people to spread out across the earth, but instead, they chose disobedience. Rather than following God's instructions, they stayed together in one place and began stacking their plans higher and higher in pride. They decided to build a tower that would reach into the heavens so they could make a name for themselves. Like players in a game of Jenga, they kept adding blocks to their tower of pride, thinking it would stand forever. God stepped in and confused their language, causing the people to scatter across the earth. Their carefully stacked plans collapsed because they were built on human pride instead of obedience to God. Even though this story shows the seriousness of sin, it is not the end of the story. God chose to form a people for Himself through the nation of Israel. Through this nation, God sent His Son, Jesus, to make a way for us to have a right relationship with Him. Just as God stopped the tower at Babel, He showed people they could not save themselves. We are all sinners who need God's rescue. Everyone who trusts in Jesus has the hope of being with Him forever. One day, people from every tribe, language, and nation will stand together worshiping God, just as we see in Revelation 7:9. What incredible hope we have in Jesus!

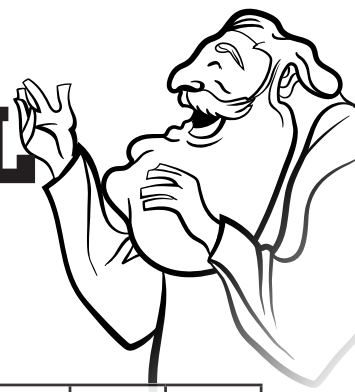
