Lesson Summary:

In Exodus 19, we learn about the **Mosaic Covenant** that God made with His chosen people, the Israelites. This happened about three months after God rescued them from slavery in Egypt. While they were camped near Mount Sinai, God met with Moses on the mountain and showed His glory in a thick cloud. God was forming a special relationship with His people. God gave the Israelites His Law, including the Ten Commandments. This covenant was a **conditional covenant**, which means the people had a part to obey. If they obeyed God's Law, they would enjoy His blessing in the land. If they disobeyed, there would be consequences and hard times. Their obedience mattered in this covenant. But the Law also had another important purpose. In Romans 3:20, the Law shows us our sin. It helps us see that no one can perfectly obey God. The Mosaic Covenant helps us understand that we cannot save ourselves. We need a perfect Savior, and that Savior is Jesus! When we trust in Jesus, our salvation is secure because it depends on Him, not on us. What a merciful and faithful Covenant Keeper we serve!

Deuteronomy 7:9

⁹ Know therefore that the Lord your God is God; he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commandments.
