Lesson Summary:

In Revelation 5, the author John saw a scroll sealed with seven seals. There was no one worthy to open it at first, so John wept. One of the elders pointed to the One who was worthy to open the scroll, Jesus. Here, He is called **"The Lion of the Tribe of Judah."** He comes from the line of King David, who established David as King. Jesus is from the tribe of Judah, which is the kingly tribe of Israel. Jesus can open the scroll because of the full victory He has.

Then John sees Jesus the Lamb, who had been killed, in the center of the throne. Jesus, the Lamb of God, took the scroll, and every created thing worshipped Him. Jesus is in full control as He paid the price for our sins on the cross and rose again. Jesus will reign on the throne forever as King! Jesus died on the cross as the Lamb of God, and He is coming back a second time as the Lion of Judah. What a mighty God we serve!

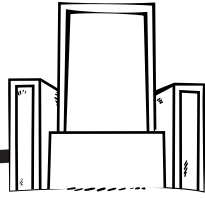
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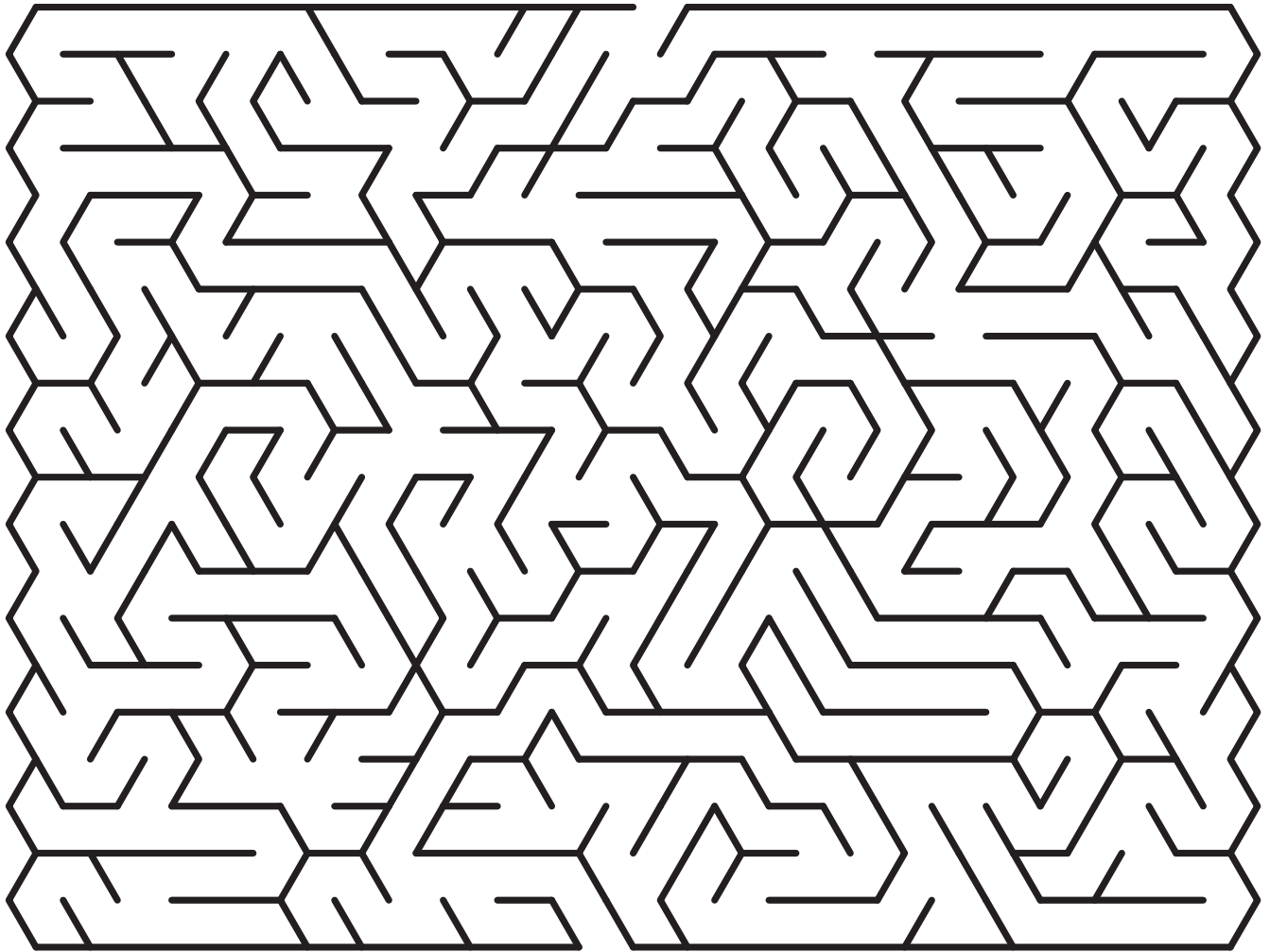
