Lesson Summary:

In the beginning of Jeremiah 23, Jeremiah focuses on false kings or shepherds that led God's people astray. God would cut off these sinful kings just like He would cut off a branch. God Himself will gather His people back to Himself. Then, God will raise up a new Shepherd to care for His flock as they were intended to be cared for. This Shepherd will be from the line, or "branch," of King David. This Branch will be righteous, doing what is both good and just. This is the complete opposite of King Jehoiachin, who was evil and was cut off as a result. This new King will be the promised Messiah, Jesus Christ. This name of God refers to both the first and second coming of Jesus. The first coming of Jesus made it possible for us to receive the free gift of salvation after Jesus' death and resurrection. The second coming of Jesus is when all of God's people who had been scattered will return to their land under the rule of Jesus Christ, our Holy King. Praise God for the hope we have in His name, Jehovah Tsidkenu!

Philippians 2:10-11
That at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
