IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: REVELATION 21:1-8

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? We will spend eternity dwelling with God in a New Heaven, New Earth, and New Jerusalem; As we join Jesus forever, He will declare with thunderous power, "It is done!"

1. Our world is a complex array of joy and pain, life and death, creative building or horrible

	destruction. Ponder these truths for a prayerful moment. Take a deep breath. Now let's look at what this passage promises.
2.	John 14:2 says that Jesus has gone to Heaven to prepare a place for us. Why do you think God is preparing a NEW Heaven and Earth, with a NEW Jerusalem?
3.	Who spoke the words, "the dwelling place of God is with man"? What does that imply about the trustworthiness of the statement?
4.	In the original language, the word for dwelling place is "tabernacle." How is the original tabernacle from the Old Testament a shadow of the tabernacle to come?

5.	Please list all the things from verses 3-6 that God will do when He brings the New Jerusalem down from Heaven. This will be endless, joy-lavishing, life-rocking perfection. How should this change our worship even now?
6.	Based on Revelation 21:6-8, who is "the one who conquers"?
7.	Please compare the "heritage" of the one who conquers in verse 7 with the outcome for those who reject God in verse 8. How might these truths lead to the statement, "God-glorifying worship is necessarily fueled by true humility"?
8.	Please list all you see about God in this passage. Which attribute is most meaningful to you in your present circumstances, and why?
