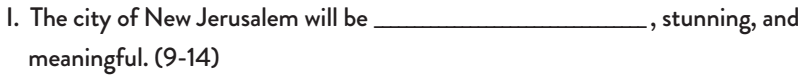

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: REVELATION 21:9-21

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *The city of New Jerusalem will be welcoming, stunning, and meaningful; The city of New Jerusalem will be massive and glorious.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

4. How would you compare a sunrise or sunset to the jewels of the Holy City of Jerusalem?

5. What do the details about the city and how He shared them with John tell you about God's...

a. Wisdom?

b. Goodness?

c. Power?

d. Any other attributes you see?
