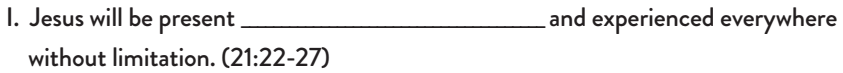

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: REVELATION 21:22-22:5

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Jesus will be present everywhere and experienced everywhere without limitation; The New Eden will be even more glorious than the old.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

From Revelation 21:22-27

1. What elements of everyday life today are used in Revelation 21:22-23? Why is there no need for them in the New Jerusalem?

2. According to Revelation 21:26-27, what will be allowed to enter the city and what won't? Why is that so awesome compared to life today?

3. Please think about the things that are most important to you in this life. How does this passage impact the way you determine what is worth holding onto and what needs to go?

4. Please note what will be in the city and what will not be in the city. What does this tell you about the heart of God?

5. Please describe what you see about the people who will live in the city with God.

6. Revelation 22:3 says, “His servants will worship Him.” Remembering back from Revelation 17, what tactics did the Beast use to get people to worship him? What reasons from this passage do you see for God’s servants to willingly worship Him?

Based on what you learned in Sunday’s message and in your study time, what is one measurable thing you will go after this week in your walk with Christ?
