IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: REVELATION 22:14-21

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Praise God that we can experience perfect, satisfying, eternal life with Jesus; Live a life that trusts these prophecies and cries out, "Come Lord Jesus!"*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Revelation 22:14 says those who have "washed their robes" are blessed. What insight does Revelation 7:14 give you about how people "wash their robes"?

2. In Revelation 22:14-15, John again describes those who are saved and those who are not. If one is saved, by what are they known? If one is not saved, by what are they known?

3. On what authority can we believe the words that we've studied in Revelation? Why is that important for our lives today?

4. How is Jesus described in Revelation 22:13 and 22:16? Why are each of those descriptions important? What is the natural, overwhelming response of one who sees Jesus as He is (verse 17)?

5. What warning is given in verses 18-19, and why do you think that warning is so strong?

6. How has your view of God been impacted through the study of Revelation?

Based on what you learned in Sunday's message and in your study time, what is one measurable thing you will go after this week in your walk with Christ?
