IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: JOHN 1:9-18

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? Receive Jesus as your Savior and Lord; Taste of His sweet grace and truth that He revealed with all of His glory.

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1.	Verse 9 says that Jesus, the true light, gave His light to everyone. Verses 10-11 show that not everyone wanted His light. Why do you think people reject His light?
2.	According to verse 12, what is our responsibility in receiving Jesus, and what is God's gift to those who do receive Him? What other things do people wrongly say they need in order to go to heaven?
	Please use the following verses to explain the importance of grace and how it impacts your understanding of the heart of God. Romans 3:23-24

c.	Romans 6:14
d.	Hebrews 4:16

Why is it significant that Jesus is full of both grace AND truth? How could having only one of those be detrimental?
