SERMON NOTES

- 1. Do you ever find it difficult to hear God speaking to you?
- 2. Ways that can help to know if God is speaking:
 - a) Does our thinking correspond with God's Word?
 - b) Do our motives correspond with God's word?
 - c) Has God opened the door to what we perceive could be His will?
 - d) Has a trusted brother or sister in Christ confirmed our thoughts?
 - e) Do we have peace in our hearts?
- 3. The disciples did not understand the parable at first. How does that shape our view on growing in our walk with Jesus?
- 4. When casting seeds, Jesus notes that seeds will not take root in certain soil, which is because of Jesus and not us. How should that comfort us?
- 5. Jesus said that if the seed (Word of God) takes root the seed will grow and bear fruit. What opportunities is God giving us to bear fruit? Do we see a need? Are we praying about those opportunities (i.e. home, work, school, ball games, neighborhood, grocery store[?])?How can God use our gifts to bear fruit? How can God use or small groups to bear fruit?
