Sermon Discussion Questions Sunday, July 27, 2025

"Confusion to Confidence" Psalm 73 Pastor Clay Smith

- 1. When have you felt disoriented in your faith like Asaph—seeing the wicked prosper while the righteous suffer?
 - How did that experience impact your trust in God?
 - What helped bring you back to a place of spiritual clarity?
- 2. Verse 17 marks a turning point: "Until I went into the sanctuary of God..."
 - How does corporate worship or Christian community help reorient your spiritual perspective?
- 3. Asaph moves from focusing on *them* (the wicked), to *I* (himself), and then to *You* (God), then You (God) and I (himself) together.
 - What does this progression teach us about where to fix our attention when life feels unfair?
 - How can this shift change our outlook in the midst of trials?
- 4. Psalm 73 ends with deep confidence: "God is the strength of my heart and my portion (inheritance) forever."
 - What does it mean for God to be your portion?
 - How might you live differently this week if you truly believed that nothing on earth compares to Him?
