**“Glory Amid Ruin”**  
**2 Samuel 22**

1. David reflects on how God delivered him throughout his life. When you look back over your own life, can you identify a time when God clearly intervened or delivered you in a powerful way? How has that shaped your faith today?
2. The sermon suggests that if we lack deep praise, it may be because we don't see how desperate we truly were or are. In what ways might we be blind to our need for God's rescue? How can we cultivate a deeper awareness of our dependence on Him?
3. David describes God shaking the heavens to deliver him. Has the Lord ever given you a peak at his "behind the scenes"—where you later realized He was at work in powerful ways during a difficult season? How does that change your understanding of the Lord's care for you NOW?
4. David's legacy was not his victories or failures, but Jesus's gracious deliverance. What legacy do you hope your life leaves behind? How does knowing that “all I have is Christ” shape the way you live now?
