"Faithful Through It All" **2 Samuel 23: 1-7** **Pastor Charles Godwin**

1. What was new, encouraging, or challenging from this message?
2. Interact with the following: *"God's people in this world seldom have circumstantial certainty, but we have kingdom certainty."*
3. How does God's faithful ordering of all things in your life give you hope?
4. Reflect on the following: *"We may feel defeated at the moment, but evil will never prevail because God is for you!"*
5. How does God's faithful securing of your life give you hope?
6. Discuss the following: *"Christians who suffer do more than suffer. They also wait. This is not the passive waiting of stoic endurance. It is rather an active resting in the goodness and faithfulness of God, with the hopeful expectation that someday one's trials will come to an end. There are times when the only thing a sufferer can do is wait for God. But waiting is good because God is worth waiting for. His salvation will come in due course."*
7. Where are the places in your life that you are struggling to have hope? How does the story of God's promised redemption give you hope in the midst?
