

"PEACE IN THE MIDST OF YOUR STORMS" Matthew 14:22-33

I want us to notice 5 anchors in this passage of Scripture, anchors which are reliable and will not let us down.

- I. God's Providence Brought Me Here
- II. God's Prayers Protect Me Here
- III. God's Presence Comes to Me Here
- IV. God's Power Sustains Me Here
- V. God's Promise Assures Me Here

FOUR REASONS FOR PRIVATE WORSHIP: #1 OF A SERIES

Reason #1—You and I need direction for the journey.

In Exodus 33, Moses is found leading God's people from Egypt to the Promised Land, a trip that should have taken only a few days ended up taking 40 years. During this time, Moses regularly meets with God in worship to gain direction for the Israelites' journey.

The direction isn't always from point A to B. God takes us down the pathways that will help to build the character that is needed for the journey. With the Israelites, He was giving them time to lose the old way of thinking, with idols and all the immorality that was learned from their time in Egypt, in order that they would be transformed into a new way of thinking, God's way of thinking.

Worship leads us to a higher level; it transcends us to a new mindset where we are more apt to receive His direction. So, I would encourage you to make time for intimate worship this week in order to discover more fully God's direction for the journey of your life.

- The people whom we sat with were not always friendly.

- We often found ourselves sitting with hypocrites. They just came
 to see their friends and what others were wearing, instead of really
 concentrating on the game.

- It seemed like the games were usually scheduled when we wanted to do other things.
- As we each look back on our respective childhoods, we feel that we were taken to too many games by our parents when we were growing up.
- We recently read a book on sports, and now we feel that we know more than the coach anyway.
- Finally, we don't want to force our children to go to any more of the games because they need to pick the sports they each like best of all.

Actually, baseball is my favorite sport. So having made those remarks "tongue-in-cheek," let me just offer a word of encouragement to so many of you who are involved in faithful service to our Lord's Kingdom. When your motives are pure before Christ and you are heavily involved in His ministry, Almighty God is actually using you to touch lives in significant ways. If you think about it, there is nothing else anywhere in all the world like this. I mean, where else does anyone get that experience of allowing God to use them as they serve Him in their sweet spot?
