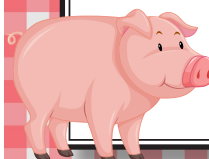

STATEMENT OF FAITH

Part Three

The past two weeks I have written about writing a Statement of Faith. I began writing about my own personal statement and challenged you to begin thinking about writing your own as well. I trust that you have taken this seriously because I believe when you accept this challenge you cannot help but grow spiritually. If you are serious about your faith, then I urge you to begin doing it now.

Life experiences, former teachings, and even personal biases help form spiritual beliefs and moral attitudes. This Statement of Faith draws primarily on Scripture and all attempts have been made to adhere to the Word of God. I acknowledge that the doctrines that are essential to salvation leave no room for debate, while liberty is extended to those who differ in belief of things that are not eternally significant provided that these issues are scripturally based.

After writing the past two week's newsletters, I am now revealing ten statements that define my faith. This entire newsletter series could be a sermon series, so for the lack of space, I will include the first two of ten statements and continue next week. 1. The Bible is the inspired Word of God and inerrant in its original manuscripts. I acknowledge that although the human writers wrote in their own unique language, those writings were inspired by God and the Holy Spirit. The Bible is the final authority on all matters that are addressed.
2. There is one Triune God, eternal and self-sufficient, existing as three distinct persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Each person of the Godhead is equal in divine nature, power, and glory.
