TEST YOUR HEART'S SOIL

Read Luke 8: 4-21! Jesus' ministry and the opposition against Him grew daily. It became necessary to know and understand what it meant to be a disciple. They listened carefully as Jesus told the parable of the soils to a large crowd who had come from several towns. This teaching was focused on the broader audience, and the farming narrative would have been familiar to most people if not all of them.

Some of you might be familiar with this parable while, for some, it might be the first you have heard this. In the parable, Jesus spoke about seeds. Some seeds fell on the road, where it was walked on or eaten by birds. Other seeds fell on rocky ground. These seeds dried up for lack of roots and water. A third set of seeds fell among the weeds, and the seedlings were easily choked out by the weeds. The rest of the seeds fell on good soil and yielded a plentiful crop.

When the disciples questioned Jesus on the parable, he explained that the seeds represented the Word of God. People responded in different ways to the message depending on the condition of their heart. That is also true today. Verses 19–21 reinforce the importance of responding to God's Word.

Question: Be brutally honest with yourself! If you did a soil test on your heart, which kind would it be? Bare road? Rocky ground? Weedy ground? Cultivated ground? We cultivate good soil by spending time daily in God's Word. Do you spend time daily in God's Word?
