#### **PRAYING WITH PURPOSE**

Praying with a purpose is commanded in the book of Philippians where we read (4:5-7, NKJV), "Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord is at hand. Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."

We shouldn't live life being anxious for anything, as the scripture says, but we should have peace that God is in control of every situation that we may be going through and that He knows what is best for us in all things. And when we humble our hearts and give Him thanks for all things, the situations around us become smaller, and what we really need to ask becomes more evident.
