GROWING IN CHRIST

"Know that a person is not justified by the works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no one will be justified." (Galatians 2-16 NIV)

This verse is talking about a law that cannot make us right before God. Rather, it is our faith with Jesus that makes us right. We were not created to please men but to please our Heavenly Father. What does the law represent? Well, in the earthly sense, it is an extensive number of commands to bring order and morality to society. If you break the law, you will receive punishment which will usually result in jail-time. In the Heavenly sense, it represents either life and Godliness or Sin and Death. In the words of Paul to the Galatians, he is saying that we need a savior (Jesus) to save us from the law of sin and death because we cannot be justified by the law, but the sacrifice of Jesus has justified us.

I remember hearing that justified means "just as if I had never sinned," because only Jesus is able to make a way for us to be free from the law of sin and death. But many are still walking in the motions of sin as spoken in Romans 7. That's why Paul states in verse 17 (of Romans 7) that Christ is not a minister of sin. We are not to continue in sin because that leaves the door open for evil influences in our lives. But Jesus is a minister of love. He gave His life to save us from the law of sin and death. Thank you, Jesus! Furthermore, let us not rebuild the old man, as spoken in verse 18, because we are crucified with Christ. So it's no longer simply we who live but Him through us. Greater is He that is in us than he that's in the world. Let's live a life worthy of the vocation of our calling. Let us be Holy for He is Holy. Hallelujah!!!
