AN HONEST TRIBUTE TO GODLY MOTHERS

As I think back to my mother when I was a child, and as I have watched our three children and eleven grandchildren relate to my wife, I have observed all of the following in action: a barber and beautician, fashion consultant, chairperson, mechanic, teacher, veterinarian, equipper, interpreter, travel agent, interior decorator, and often the last one to bed each night.

For each of these women, their ability to love has been exceeded only by God’s love. That is, there are no depths to which a child can fall that will diminish her love, and yet no heights of success that will increase it.
