

"THE SPIRITUAL GIFT OF MISSIONARY" Ephesians 3:1-13 and Acts 14:21-28

The 5 well-known passages of Scripture which cite the "gifts of the Holy Spirit" are: Romans 12

I Corinthians 12 (twice)

Ephesians 4

& I Peter 4

What are the key functions of a missionary who is operating within his/her calling or spiritual giftedness? A missionary is able to:

- #1 Preach/Teach the Gospel in such a way as to lead people to Jesus Christ and eventually develop them into mature disciples in a cross-cultural setting
- #2 Encourage and strengthen those who are already believers
- #3 Appoint the spiritual leaders in the various churches that they start
- #4 Spiritually equip himself/herself
- #5 Lead an itinerant ministry when necessary
- #6 Report back to the supporting church or missionary sending agency
