

RADICAL MENTORING OVERVIEW

GROUP MENTORING

Mentors take a group (4-8) of men that are a couple of seasons of life behind them and mentor them for ten to twelve months. The group gets together once-a-month for three hours as well as for two overnight retreats.

READ A BOOK

In between the once-a-month meetings, the mentor assigns a book that all the mentees read. They write a one-page net-out of what they learned and bring it to the next session.

MEMORIZE A VERSE

Between sessions, the mentees are assigned two verses of Scripture to memorize. They must come to the next meeting prepared to recite the verses from memory.

GROWTH ASSIGNMENT

Each month homework assignments are given to the mentees to complete. They are to come ready to report on their results at the next meeting. Assignments are designed to help the men become better Jesus-followers, husbands, fathers, and leaders.

COMMUNITY

Through the shared pursuit growing in their faith and living a God-centric life, authentic community develops between the mentees as they learn how to build accountability through closeness.

PRAYER

Throughout the mentoring season, mentees are asked to regularly pray for their mentor, the other group members, and themselves, that they would grow in their relationships with each other and with Jesus.
