How does this help you trust God, knowing He knows the future?

<p>Read</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Matthew 21:1-16 <p>Discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you’ve heard this story many times, what is something new you noticed that you may not have noticed before? 	<p>Questions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What kind of King do you want Jesus to be? How does this compare to who He is? What do you currently need to lay down at the feet of Jesus? In Luke’s Gospel, Jesus says that God will be praised by humans or the rocks themselves!
