<p><b>Prayer</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Take prayer requests and pray for each other.</li> </ul> <p><b>Scripture Memory</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recite any Scriptures you have been working on.</li> </ul> <p><b>Service Projects</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Now that we are beginning our Third Trimester, this is a great time to think about ways our Small Group could serve together this Spring. Consider helping a widow with yard work, or help out one of our Ministry Partners with a service project (See “Serving Opportunities Hub” under the “Resources” tab in our Small Group Leaders Group)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Read</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Luke 24:36-48</li> <li>John 20:24-28</li> </ul> <p><b>Discuss</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What was the common response the disciples had when they saw Jesus for the first time in His resurrected state? Does this surprise you? Why or why not?</li> <li>In Luke 24, Jesus “opened their minds to understand the Scriptures” (v.45). What did they not yet understand that He still needed to teach them?</li> <li>How does this factor into our call to “make disciples” as Jesus commands us to in Matthew 28?</li> </ul>
(2) Read Scripture	(4) Application
<p><b>Read</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Matthew 27:62–28:20</li> </ul> <p><b>Discuss</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Most of us are familiar with the end of this passage, but what stuck out to you about the rest of this account?</li> </ul>	<p><b>Questions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If you were standing on the mountain with Jesus, would you be one who worshipped or one who doubted, and why?</li> <li>Has there ever been a time in your life where you have doubted?</li> <li>How do these passages encourage us in our doubts?</li> <li>Is there someone that God is calling you to share your faith with or disciple? Who is it?</li> <li>Close in prayer for each other.</li> </ul> <p><b>Scripture Memory:</b> John 20:29 Close in prayer.</p>
