(1) Getting Started	(3) Digging Deeper
Prayer Requests - Take prayer requests and spend time as a group in prayer, either at the beginning or end of the meeting. Getting to Know You - Who/what brought you to our church family? - How has God been faithful to you during that time? Serving Opportunity - If you are choosing not to host a Halloween block party, how else can your group serve together this semester?	Read Hebrews 3:1-6 - This passage compares Jesus with Moses - In what way is Jesus superior to Moses? - What are we (NT Christians) referred to in this passage? - How is Jesus faithful to us? Read Revelation 19:1-16; 20:7-10 - How is Jesus ultimately going to fulfill His promise to be “Faithful and True” to the church?
(2) Read Scripture	(4) Application
Read Leader: Have the group break up into groups of two or three, and assign a passage (or two) to each group. Have each group return and: (1) read their passage out loud (2) report what they discovered about God’s faithfulness in that passage. 1 John 1:9 2 Timothy 2:11-13 Hebrews 2:16-18 1 Corinthians 1:4-10 1 Corinthians 10:13 1 Thessalonians 5:23-25	Questions - It can be easy to look at the disfunction within churches and lose hope in Jesus’ plan for “the church”. - How have these verses encouraged you? - God has been incredibly faithful to our church. - How did hearing some of those stories from Sunday’s service encourage you? - What can we, as a group, do to make sure there is always “more room at the table” for those God wants to bring into our family? Prayer - Close in a time of thanksgiving for God’s faithfulness to us.
