Questions **God** Asks

Can These Bones Live?

Ezekiel 37:3

CONNECT

1. How are you processing this difficult season at NHC?

GOING DEEPER

2. Pray together for God to give understanding and faith as you dig into this passage.
3. Read Ezekiel 37:1–14. What did Ezekiel see and what did it represent?
4. What were some of the things that led to spiritual death for the people of Israel? What things or influences deplete our spiritual life?
5. Read Romans 8:9–11. What brings life in people? What does it look like to pursue that?
6. In verse 7, Ezekiel hears the sound of the bones rattling as they are brought to life. When you hear about things like the Asbury Revival, what's your response? Is it longing? Skepticism? Curiosity? Why?

ACTION

7. Let's focus on two words from the question God asked Ezekiel in verse 3—can and these. Talk about how you respond to each of those words. Do you believe God can bring dead bones to life? What dead bones do you have a hard time believing God can revive?
8. In Ezekiel 37:14, God promises that His Spirit will come and bring life to that which is dead. Read that verse aloud and then pray together for those dry and dead places, that God will bring life and revival.
