CONNECT

1. We know of God as Father (e.g., "Our Father, who is in Heaven . . ."). But what is your reaction to the idea that God also has the posture of a mother?

GOING DEEPER

2. Read Isaiah 40:1. Can you think of a time when God has been a comforter to you in your life?
3. Consider Isaiah 66:12–13. In what ways is God presented here as both father and mother?
4. How does the imagery in these two verses shape or inform your view of God?
5. Beyond Isaiah 66:13, what other biblical storylines depict the Lord as a mother?
6. See the Apostle Paul's words in 1 Thessalonians 2:7. What do you think it looked like for Paul to be this and how can we be like this today?

ACTION

7. Think of that specific person you are going to seek out and comfort? Who is it and when will you make that effort?
