## **Discussion Guide**

May 21, 2023

#### **GUARANTEED** 2 Corinthians 1:21–22

#### **CONNECT**

1. In what ways have family or neighbors with disabilities proven themselves to be more able in certain areas than you might have expected? What did you learn?

#### **GOING DEEPER**

- 2. Read John 9:1-4. When you see someone who is disabled, do you see him or her through Jesus' eyes or the eyes of Jesus' disciples?
- 3. What three promises are revealed in 2 Corinthians 1:21-22?
- 4. Which one of the three promises is most meaningful to you?
- 5. Satan is a liar and the father of lies (John 8:44). How do the promises of 2 Corinthians 1:21-22 strengthen you to resist the devil?
- 6. Read Ephesians 1:13-14. How does the Holy Spirit's role as the "guarantee of our inheritance" encourage you in your walk with Christ? See also Jesus' words in John 10:27-29.

#### **ACTION**

- 7. John 9:3-4 suggests one who is disabled can display the works of God. How can this shape your interaction with those who are disabled?
- 8. How can you use 2 Corinthians 1:21-22 to share the gospel with someone? Who might that person be? Pray now for an opportunity to do so.
