GUARANTEED 2 Corinthians 1:21–22

CONNECT

1. In what ways have family or neighbors with disabilities proven themselves to be more able in certain areas than you might have expected? What did you learn?

GOING DEEPER

2. Read John 9:1-4. When you see someone who is disabled, do you see him or her through Jesus' eyes or the eyes of Jesus' disciples?
3. What three promises are revealed in 2 Corinthians 1:21-22?
4. Which one of the three promises is most meaningful to you?
5. Satan is a liar and the father of lies (John 8:44). How do the promises of 2 Corinthians 1:21-22 strengthen you to resist the devil?
6. Read Ephesians 1:13-14. How does the Holy Spirit's role as the "guarantee of our inheritance" encourage you in your walk with Christ? See also Jesus' words in John 10:27-29.

ACTION

7. John 9:3-4 suggests one who is disabled can display the works of God. How can this shape your interaction with those who are disabled?
8. How can you use 2 Corinthians 1:21-22 to share the gospel with someone? Who might that person be? Pray now for an opportunity to do so.
