Kids Day Camp

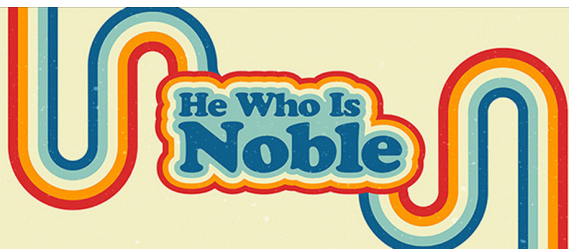

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS // JUNE 11

For Want of a Man

Isaiah 32:1-5

CONNECT

1. There is a lot of talk today about masculinity. When you hear that word, what comes to mind?

GOING DEEPER

2. Isaiah 32:1 highlights the kingship of the promised Lord Jesus. Read Philippians 2:9–11. What remains the best response to Jesus' royalty? How is this evidenced in your life?
3. Isaiah 32:1–2 offers a vision about Jesus and those who follow Him. How can you square this with Philippians 2:4–8?
4. Read Isaiah 32:2. Who are the men in your life who embody this vision? Tell their stories.
5. Isaiah 32:4 refers to one who is hasty in spirit and stammers with the tongue. Read through James 3:1–12. What can we learn from these two passages about being less hasty and more thoughtful with our words?

ACTION

6. Look again at Isaiah 32:2. How might you personally embody this vision in the world around you?
7. From Isaiah 32:1–4, how can you convey the beauty of the gospel to another?
