CONNECT

1. What does “church” mean to you?

GOING DEEPER

2. Read Acts 2:42–44. As you see the early church in action, what stands out to you?
3. The words “fellowship” (v42) and “common” (v44) share the same root in the Greek language suggesting common ground and togetherness. What is it about being together and sharing values and goods that make a community strong? How can New Hope Church do this better?
4. Acts 2:42 positions the apostles’ teaching before the believers’ fellowship. Why is this detail important? See Acts 20:26–30 for insight.
5. Consider 1 Corinthians 11:17–34. How does the Lord’s Supper instruct us regarding unity and fellowship?

ACTION

6. Review New Hope Church’s four [Strategic Values](#): Connection, Multiplication, Serving and All Peoples. In what way do these four items reflect and strengthen our togetherness as God’s people? How can you embody these more fully?
7. With whom will you share the gospel of Jesus this week? Pray and then step toward this opportunity.
