WALK IN THE TRUTH John 17:17–19

CONNECT

1. Take a couple minutes to share how God's truth (the gospel) delivered you from the dark lies that had you bound (e.g., addiction, sin, rebellion, guilt).

GOING DEEPER

2. What is the significance of obedience to truth (vv. 6, 8, 14, 17)?
3. How does truth equip the believer to experience courage against hatred/persecution from the world (vv. 11, 15–17)? Have you ever experienced opposition on account of your Christian profession?
4. What does unity referred by Christ mean (vv. 20–21, 23)?
5. Believers come from different backgrounds, traditions and personalities. Why it is so difficult for people from different backgrounds to come together and form a unified community, even when they are united by the love that Jesus described (vs. 23)?

ACTION

6. How does our walking in truth testify to the world that we are Christ's disciples (John 13:35)? What tangible examples can you identify that witness to the world?
7. The world we live in is filled with lots of beauty. However, much of what we hear/see on the news is unfortunate. How can we engage a hostile society with God's truth (gospel)? Ask the Lord who you could share the gospel truth with today.
