GIVE GOD GLORY Romans 12:1

CONNECT

1. Share about a time when you felt you had made a great sacrifice and why.

GOING DEEPER

2. What does the Bible describe as glory? What is the glory of the Lord? Where do we see it in the Bible?
3. What does worship mean to you? Does it mean attending Sunday service, praising or something more?
4. Read Romans 12:1–2. How does being a living sacrifice in verse 1 help us to not conform to this world by the renewing of our mind in verse 2?

ACTION

5. Are there areas in your life you are holding back glory from God by not worshiping Him with every part of your life?
6. Read Romans 12:9–18. Choose one of the exhortations from Paul in this passage as an area for growth for yourself. Ask the group to pray for God's help to become a living sacrifice in that area of your life.
