Moms Together

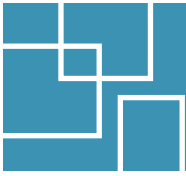

CONNECT

1. Share of a time when you experienced the richness of someone else's culture and background.

GOING DEEPER

2. Read Genesis 14. Summarize the passage. How did Melchizedek honor Abraham? How is that important for us today?
3. See Romans 15:14–29. What is going on in this passage and how does it instruct us today?
4. How does the reality of Philippians 3:20 influence the way you live within a complex and diverse world? In what ways can you make this reality a prevailing life-priority?

ACTION

5. Who is the "Spaniard" (see Romans 15:28)—that person beyond your own comfort and culture—to whom you will reveal the love of Jesus?
6. How will you show that person the bread and wine, the body and blood of Christ? See Philippians 2:5 for encouragement.
