DISCUSSION GUIDE October 15, 2023

JAMES: COMPASSION & CARE

James 2

1. Read James 2:8. Showing love to others does change the people around you. But in what way does loving our neighbors impact your own life, your own spiritual growth and maturity?
2. James 2:23–24 underscores that Abraham is declared righteous by his faith in God. But he also displayed faith through his works (see James 2:21–22). How do you see your faith displayed through your works?
3. Carefully observe the practical examples in James 2. How does the way we treat people from different backgrounds show the love of Christ and the gospel's reach to the wider community?
4. If loving your neighbors reveals our love for God, how can you tangibly love all people in your community well this week?
