August 10, 2025 Exodus 12:43-51 A Faith Remembered and Practiced

- 1. What does the celebration of the Passover signify in terms of God's faithfulness and our salvation, and how does it relate to our faith today? In what ways can you celebrate and remember God's faithfulness in your own life?
- 2. Why does Pastor emphasize that 'our faith is exclusive' and what scriptural basis does he provide for this claim? How can understanding the exclusivity of faith in Christ influence the way you share your beliefs with others?
- 3. How does the idea of our faith being 'available' reflect God's desire for people to come to Him, and what does that mean for non-believers? What steps can you take to help someone understand that faith in Christ is available to them?
- 4. Pastor talks about our faith being 'covenantal' and relates it to baptism as a sign of the new covenant. Why do you think this is important for believers? How does participating in baptism as a community strengthen your understanding of your faith?
- 5. What does Pastor mean when he says, 'our faith is congregational,' and why is community important in the life of a believer? In what ways can being part of a church community impact your spiritual growth and support?
