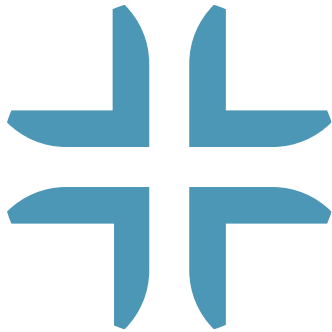




Sermon Discussion Questions

Exodus 18

What God Can Do

1. In the sermon, Pastor Kyler discusses how Jethro's conversion demonstrates that God can save anybody. What are the three key steps to salvation that were illustrated through Jethro's story? Think about your own journey of faith - how did you first hear about God, and what led you to believe and turn to Him?
2. How does Exodus 18:1-12 challenge our assumptions about who can be saved and used by God? Who in your life have you perhaps written off as 'unsavable'? How does Jethro's story challenge that thinking?
3. The sermon discusses how Moses demonstrated his faith publicly through naming his sons Gershom and Eleazar. Why is living out our faith publicly important, and what are some ways we can do this authentically? In what areas of your life do you find it most challenging to live out your faith publicly, and why?
4. Pastor Kyler emphasizes that God often uses unlikely people and circumstances to change us. How do we see this principle at work in the relationship between Moses and Jethro? Can you identify a time when God used an unexpected person or situation to teach or change you?
5. The sermon outlines four qualities needed to be useful in God's hands: being charitable, honest, humble, and teachable. Which of these qualities do you think is most challenging for Christians today, and why? Which of these four qualities do you personally struggle with most, and what practical steps could you take to grow in that area?
