Work OUT your salvation, not FOR your salvation.

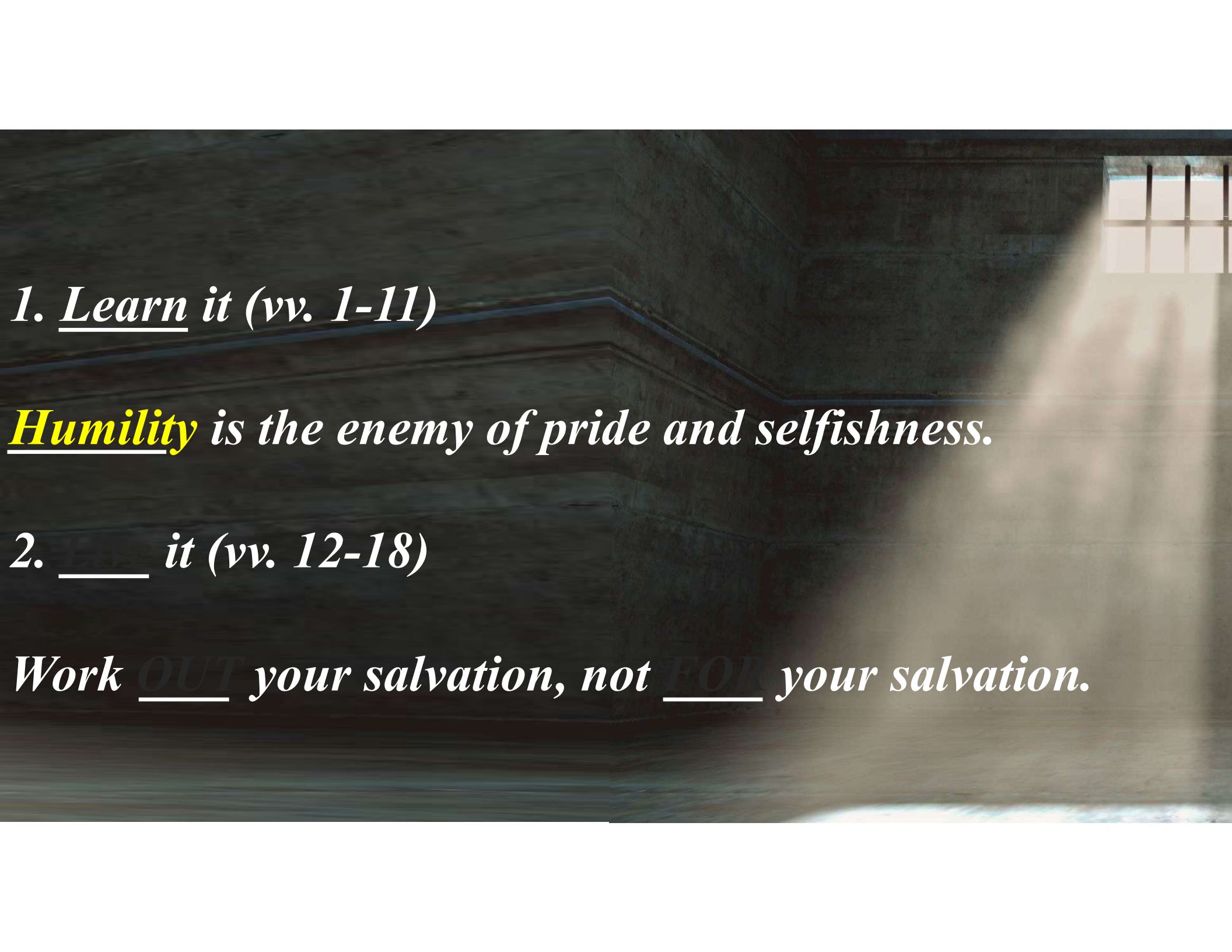


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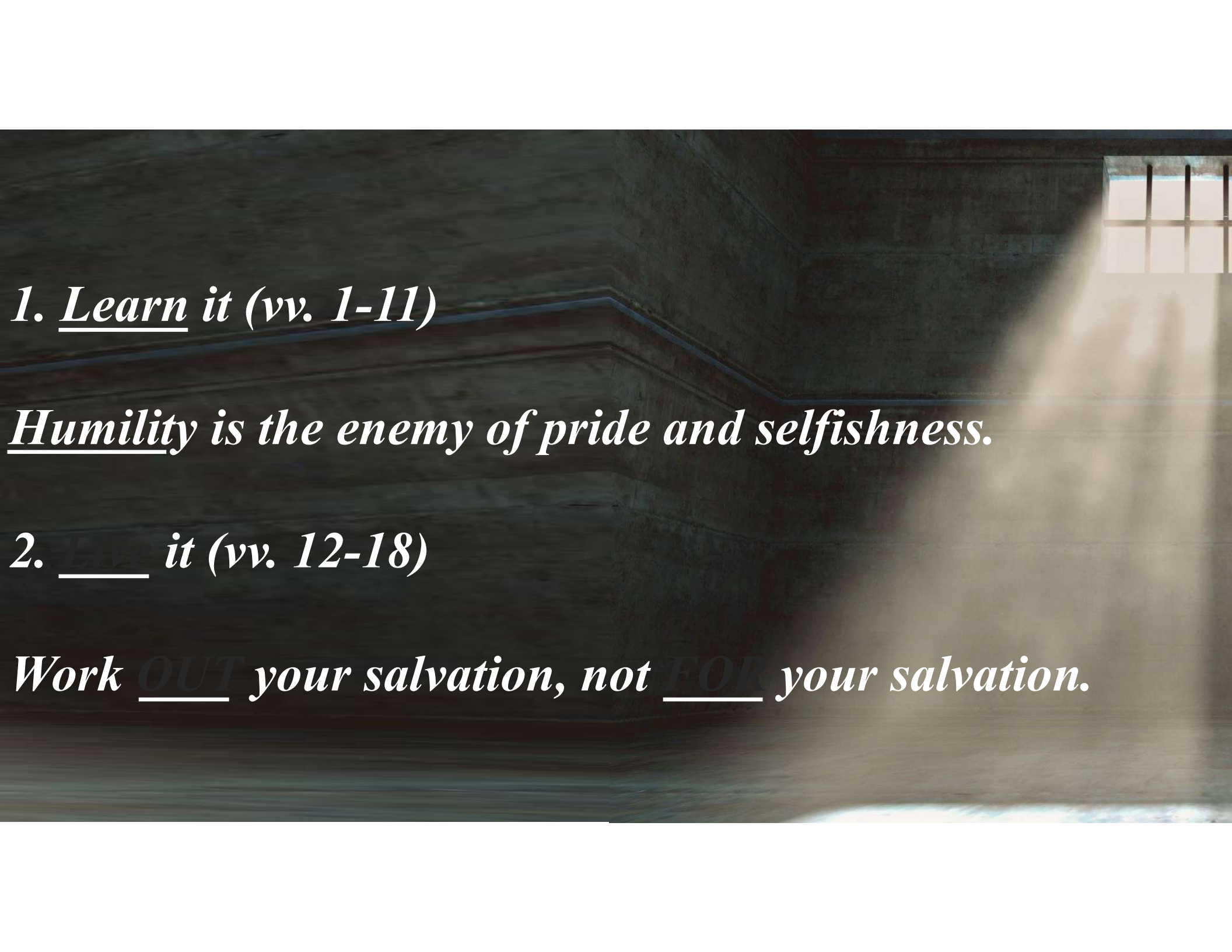

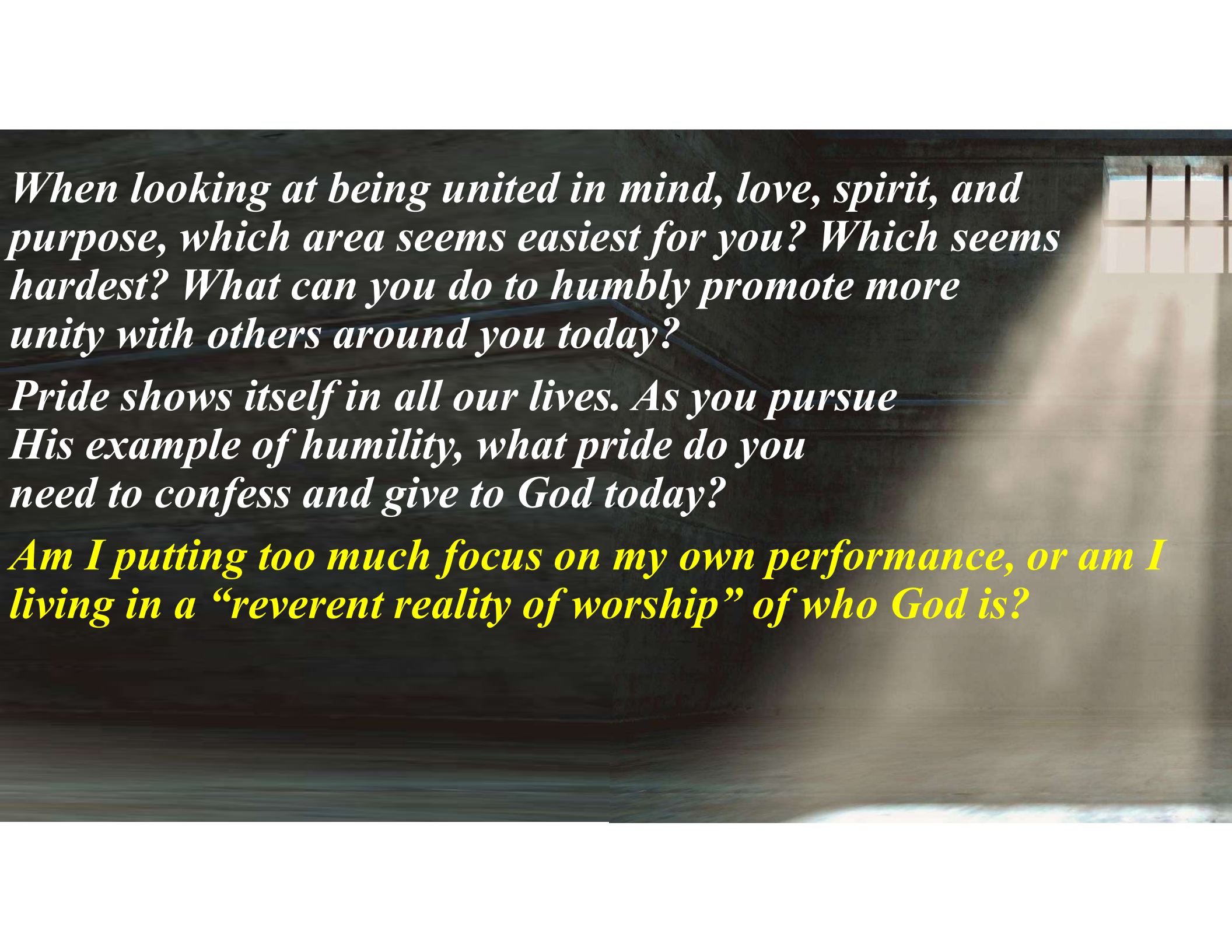


When looking at being united in mind, love, spirit, and purpose, which area seems easiest for you? Which seems hardest? What can you do to humbly promote more unity with others around you today?



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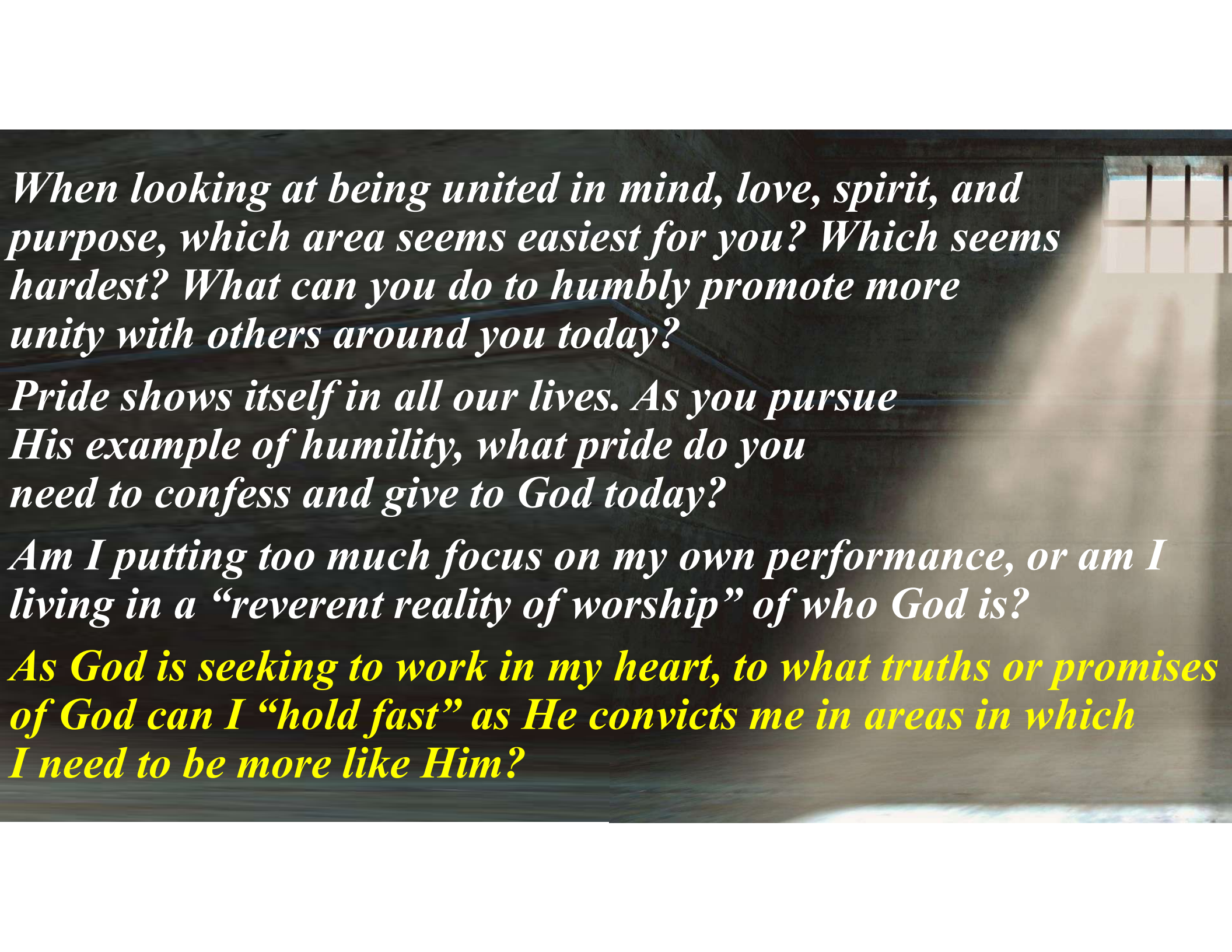
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Am I putting too much focus on my own performance, or am I living in a “reverent reality of worship” of who God is?

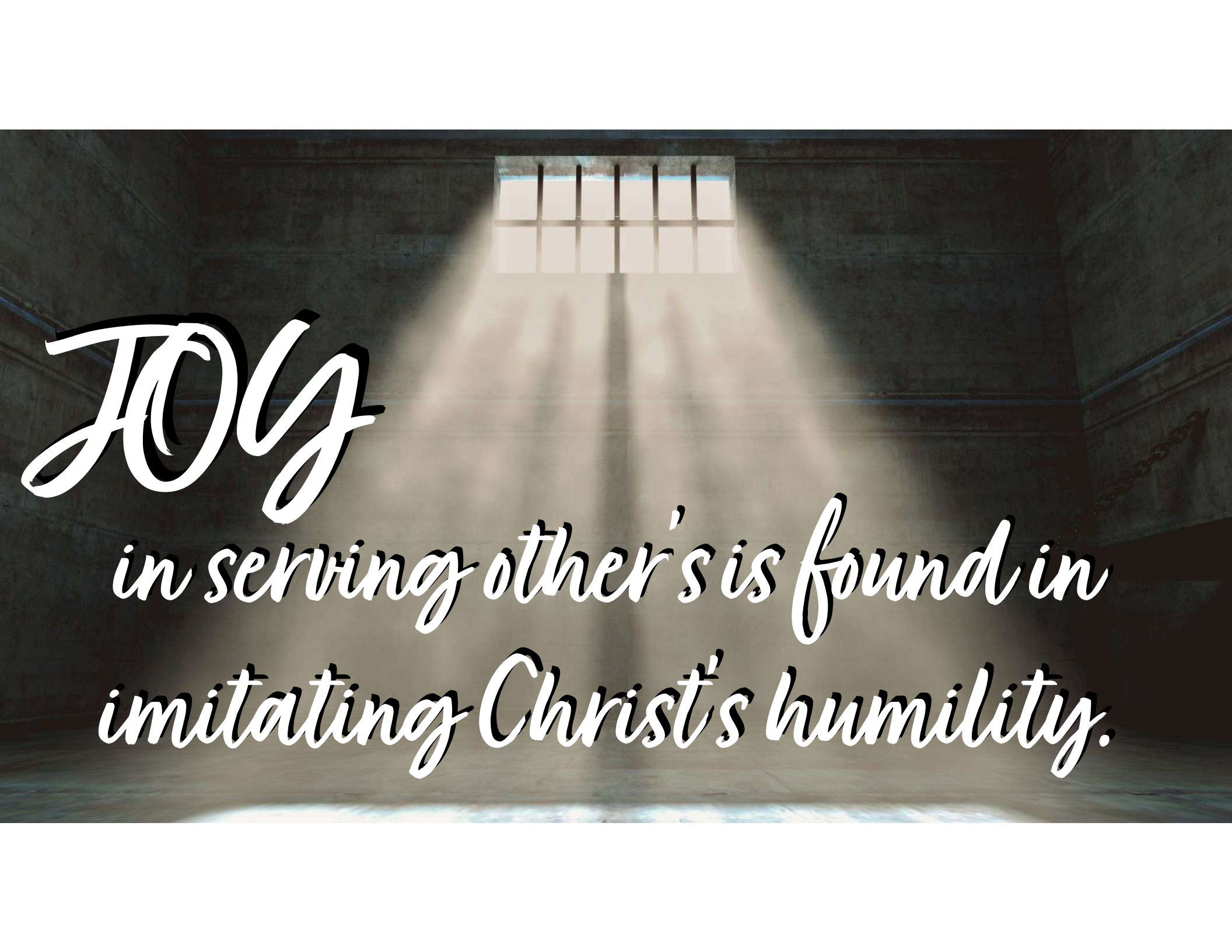


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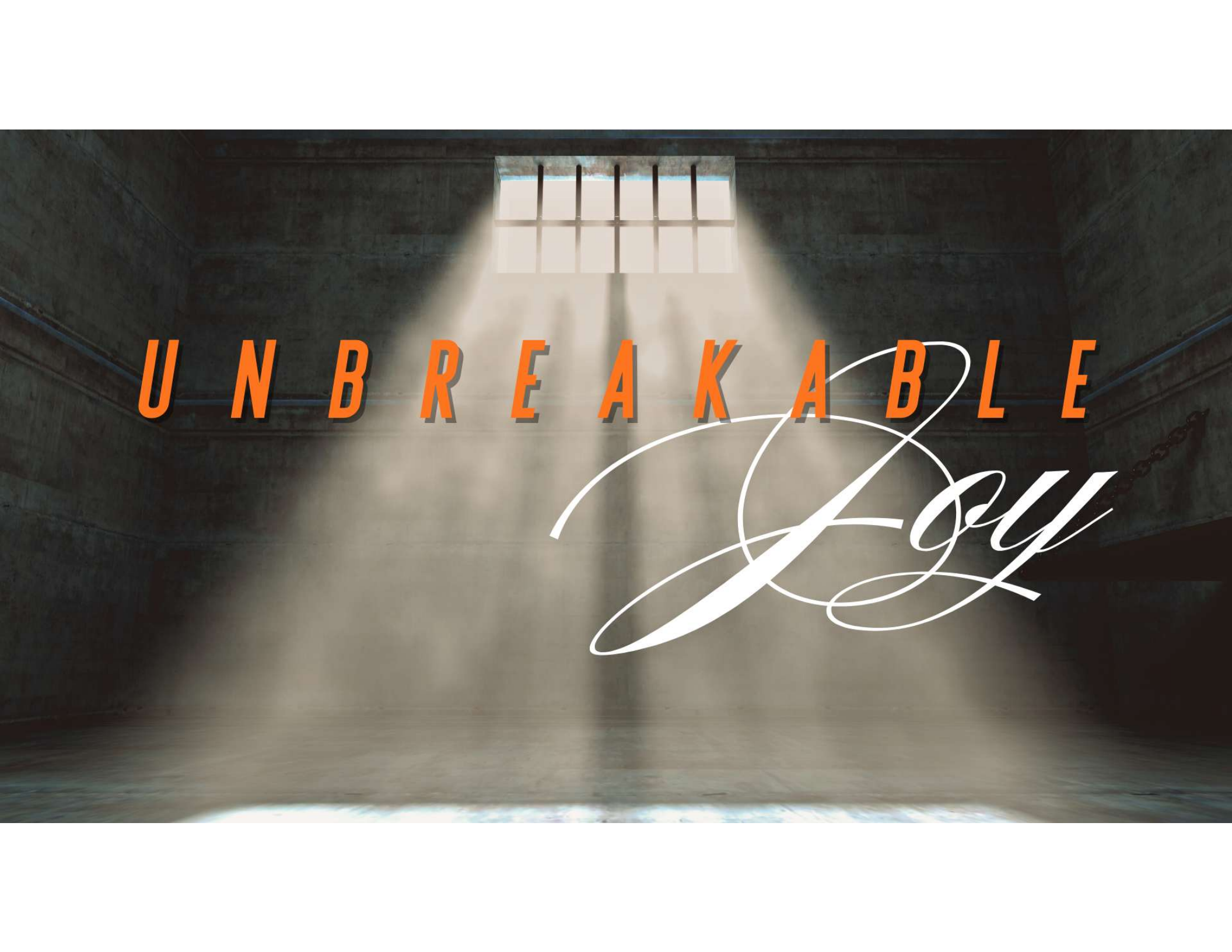
