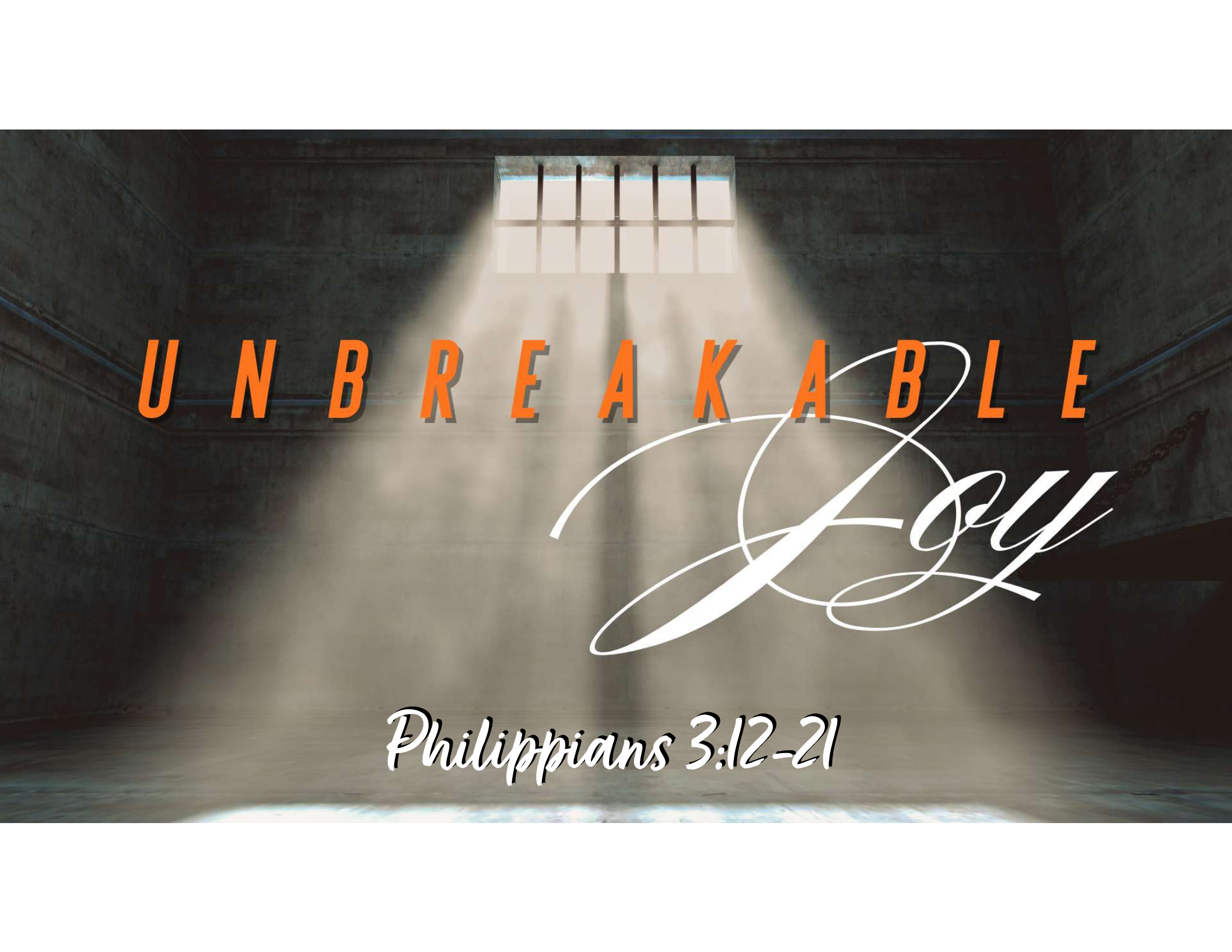

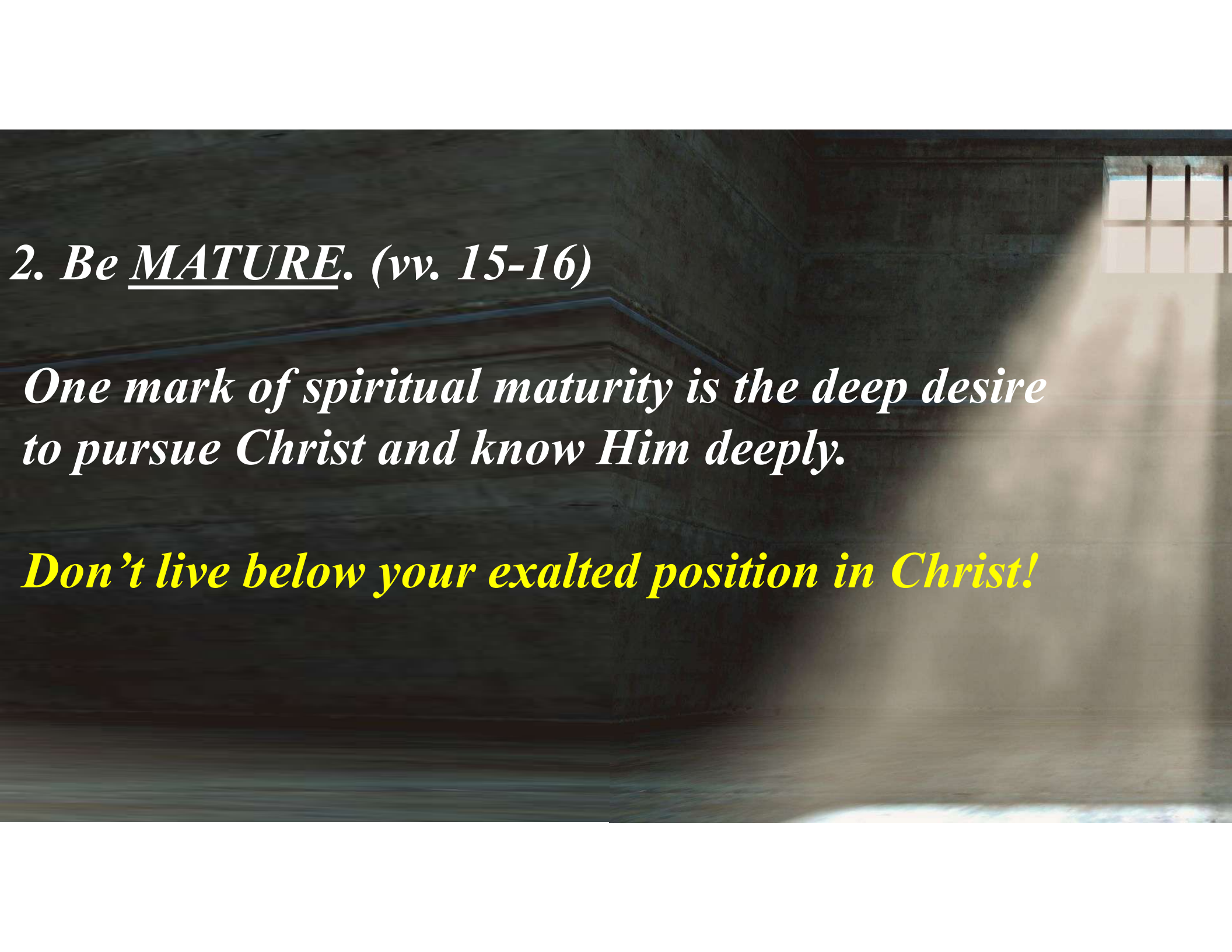

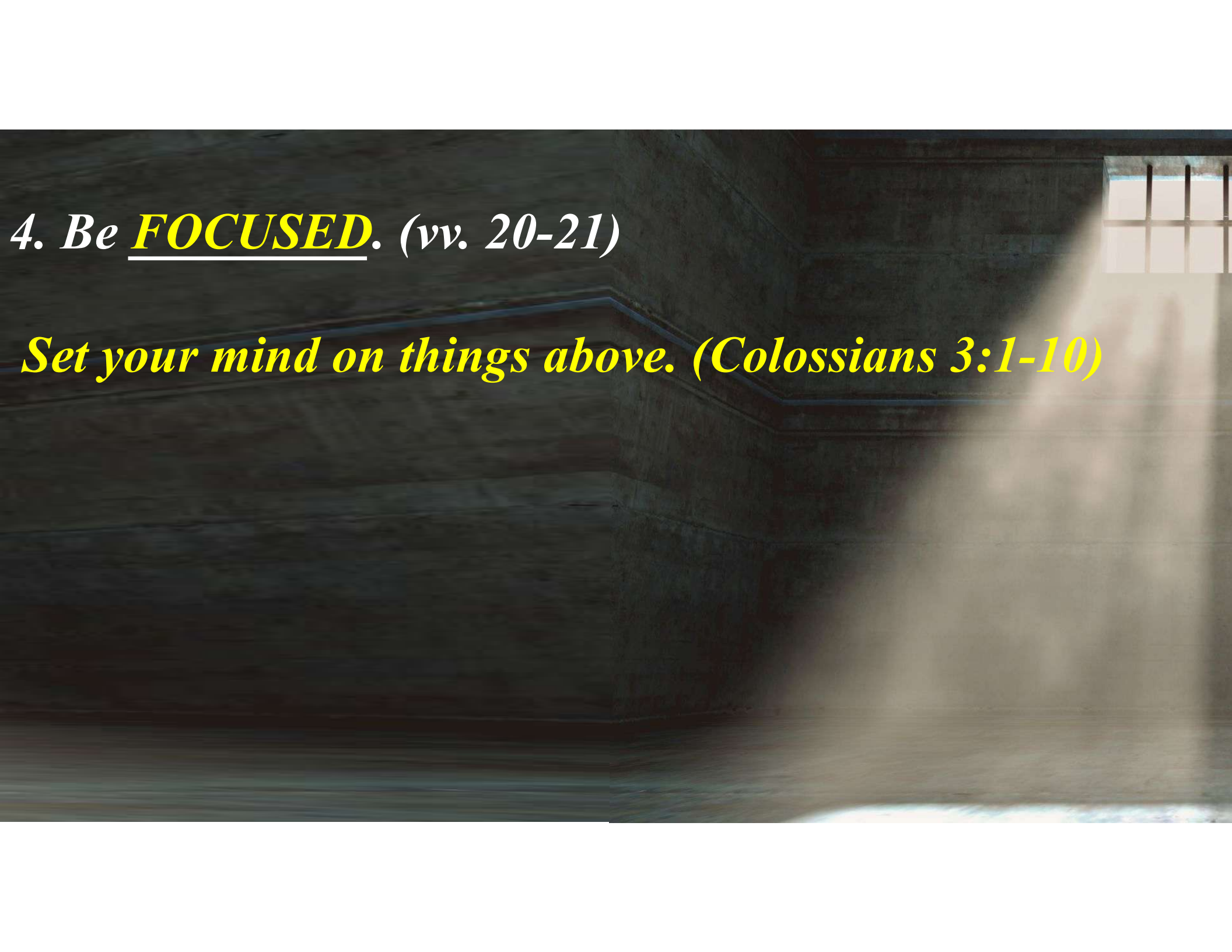

4. *Be* FOCUSED.



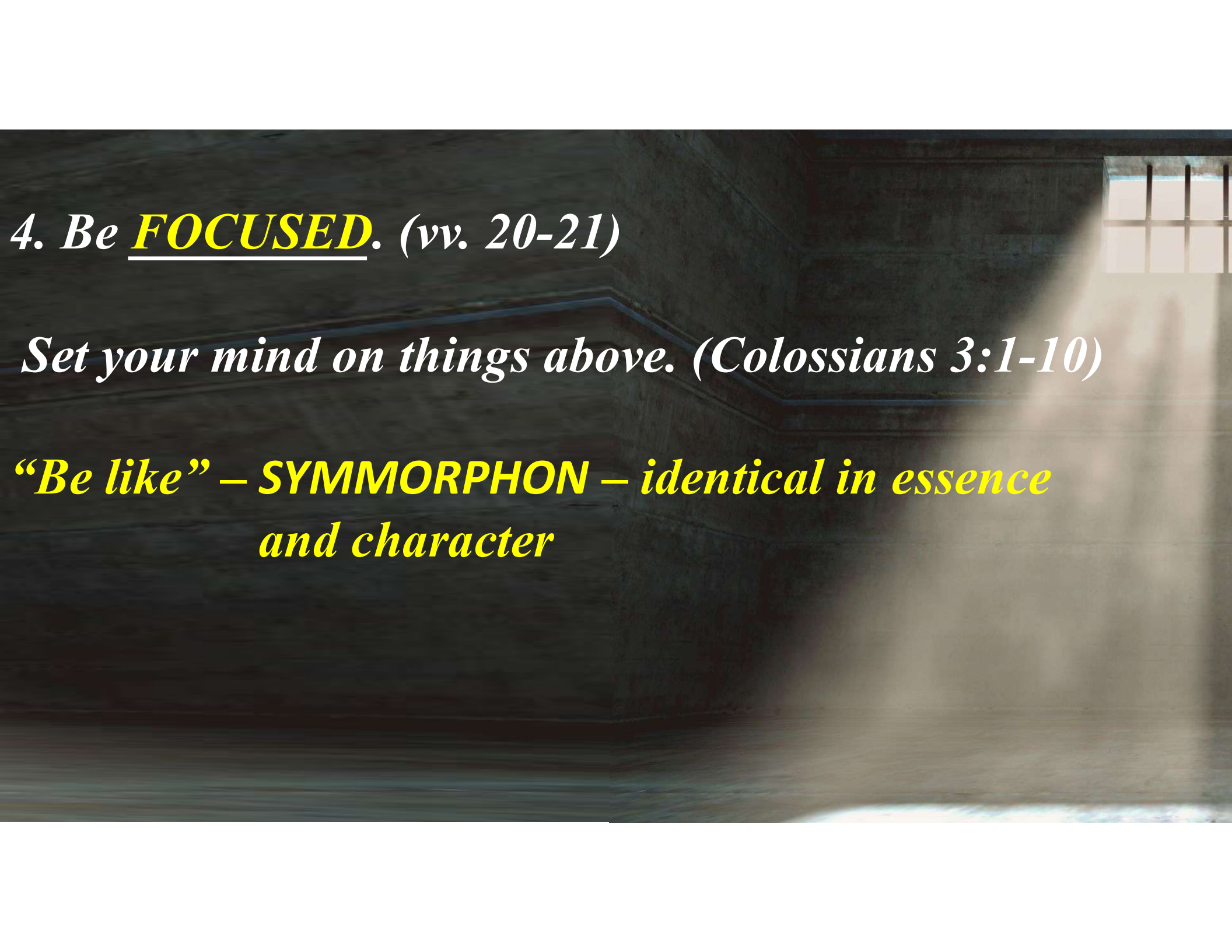

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We must practice spiritual discernment as we go about our lives. In what area of my heart do I need more discernment?

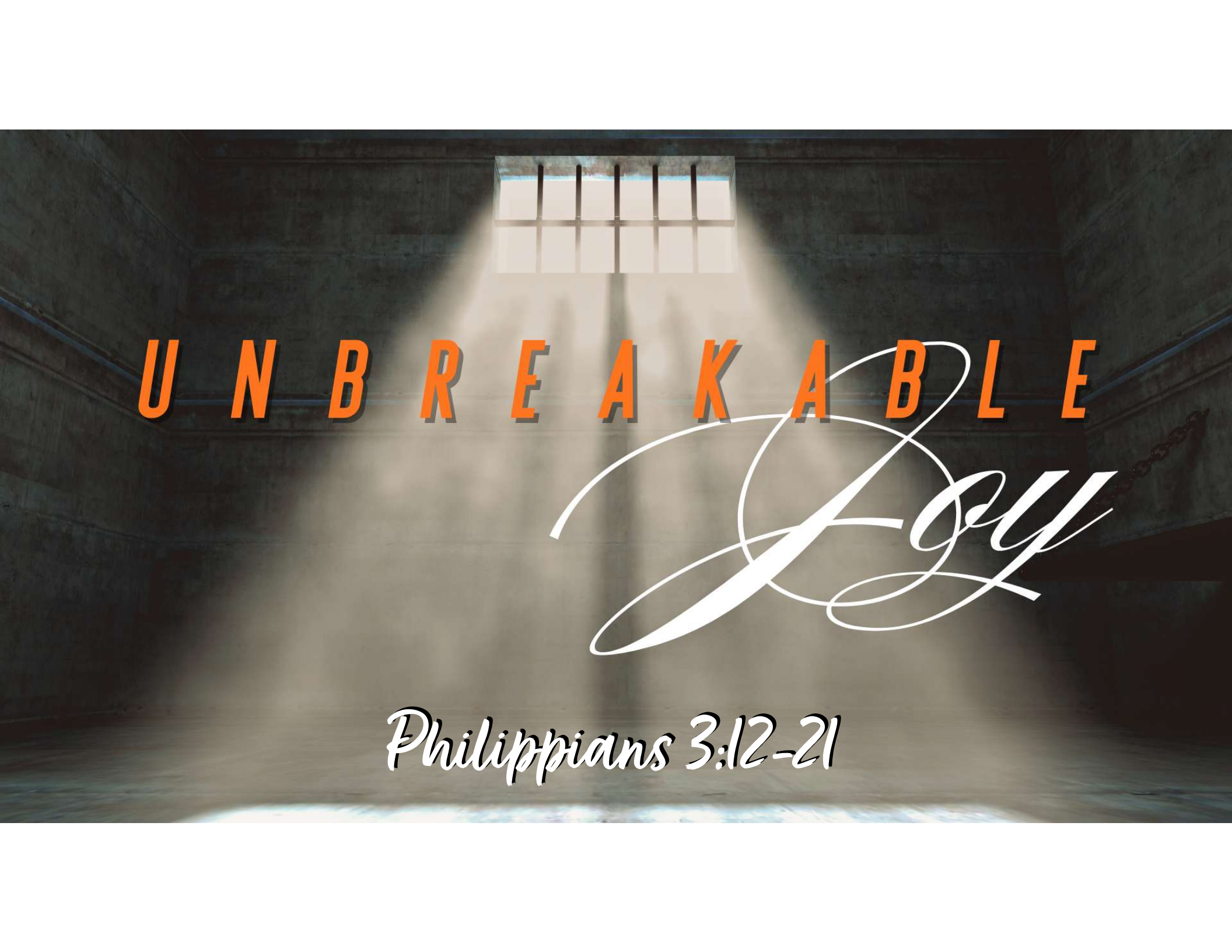


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What practical habits can I build for myself to set my mind on Godly things more often?
