*Cubit = about 18 inches*

*Span = 1/2 cubit, about 9 inches*

*Wait (Heb.) – “kavah” – an active, expectant hope and anticipation; a full trust and tightly entwined connection*

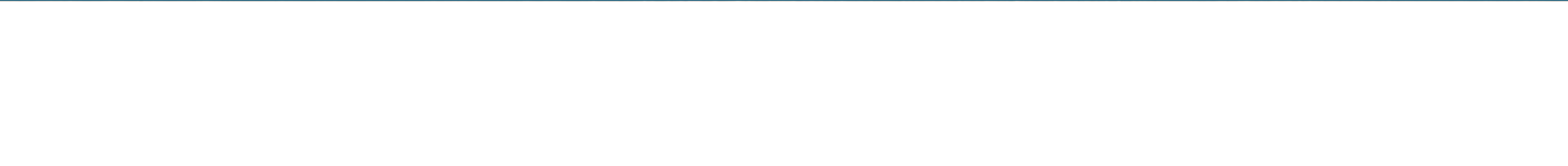
