Grace Institute

Grace Institute provides a structured and communal class environment for the GBC family to grow in their knowledge of God, his Word, and discipleship to Jesus (Romans 8:30, Colossians 2:8-9, 2 Peter 1:5). Every follower of Jesus is called to a life-long journey of discipleship or "learning", and we want to help you do that. For those exploring faith in Jesus, we believe learning plays a key role, and we hope one of these classes can help you on your journey (John 20:31).

AT A GLANCE:

We offer classes in four categories:

- Foundational Theology - What should we believe and why?
- Spiritual Formation - How can my heart be formed into the person of Jesus?
- Mission - How can I engage in God's mission in my community and the world?
- Practical Theology - How do I live out the gospel in a particular area of my life?

How long: Most of our classes are short-term (3-10 weeks)

Women of Grace Bible Studies

For any woman post High School

- Tuesday mornings 9:30-11:30 starting 9/15/26.
 - Childcare provided on a first come/first serve basis as space allows
- Wednesday Evenings 6-8 pm starting 9/16/26
 - No childcare

Registration will begin Saturday, August 1.

Cost will vary \$15-\$28 depending on study

Deep Discipleship

This “Deeper Dive” Bible Study is a rich, comprehensive curriculum from J.T. English, Jen Wilkin and Kyle Worley. The purpose of this 25-week course is to disciple us into a greater love and knowledge of God.

The course utilizes both video teaching and in-depth discussion during each class time. It includes a clear scope of discipleship and integrated curriculum which balances Christian story (Bible literacy), Christian belief (theological literacy), and Christian formation (spiritual disciplines).

This is a 2.5 hour course with homework. There is a 12-participant maximum. Participants will be registered on a case by case basis with a brief interview required. Cost: \$125. We will not be offering child care during this course.

Tools to Dig Your Wells - Building Out Your Bible Study Toolkit

An interactive roundtable series to discuss (and practice) resources to unlock deeper connection with God through His Word including:

- mindset and heart posture - prayer - guardrails to sound study
- questions to ask before starting - an exegesis framework - tools for literary interpretation
- 1st century Hebraic interpretation tools including worldview - meditation - supplemental resources.

Women leave with a starter bible study toolkit with examples for aiding in uncovering historical, cultural, linguistic, relational, and spiritual layers of the text.

Digging Wells

A dynamic study format, wrestling through scripture as a group, in relationship with God and each other. Follows a reading schedule working through a book of the Bible.

- Pre-group - individually pray/read passage 3x
- During group - first half each share what God illuminated; second half, walk through passage to peel back layers *together* utilizing methods from 'Tools to Dig Your Wells' bible study toolkit (provided)

Breakfast / Lunch / Supper Clubs

Piloting this fall and rolling out over time, groups of 5-10 women connecting 2x a month over a meal (either Breakfast, Lunch or Dinner). A short scripture anchors the topic of each gathering, and women explore together what that reveals about God, how to connect with Him, and what that means in our lives and hearts. 2-4 questions help start the discussion as women are invited to build more authentic and life giving relationships with each other and God in the process.
